COME NOW John Doe I, John Doe II, and John Doe IV, Plaintiffs herein, and file this, their *Third Amended Petition and Request For Jury Trial*, complaining of Defendants, Roman Catholic Diocese of Dallas; by and through its Bishop, Kevin J. Farrell, D.D., his predecessors and successors, in his official capacity as Bishop of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Dallas, hereinafter collectively referred to as "Defendants," and plead as follows:

PARTIES

1.01 Plaintiff John Doe I (hereinafter "Doe I") resides in Dallas County, Texas. He is an adult male whose identity is known to Defendants. Plaintiff Doe I was a minor and a resident of Dallas County, Texas at the time of all sexual abuse and all sexual exploitation by Monsignor Richard E. Johnson (hereinafter "Johnson" or "Father Johnson") alleged herein. Johnson, when he was pastor of St. Bernard of Clairvaux Catholic Church in Dallas, sexually abused Doe I, his
